

## Compliance & Risk Management Back to Basics: Ask Me!

# Assignment:



Ask Compliance committee members to wear the provided "Ask me" buttons to prompt team members to ask them about their work. Below are suggested topics with talking points.

This is a great opportunity to reinforce certain important messages identified by the committee. Consider using Who, What, When, Where, Why and How as the basis for your talking points.



#### Hotline

- Where to find the hotline number within your organization.
- It is anonymous. Caller is given a reference number to call back for follow-up if desired.
- Organization's commitment to non-retaliation for reporting.
- Conduct full investigation on all hotline calls. Process, findings and resolutions are all documented.

#### Protected Health Information (PHI)

- What is PHI examples of PHI (make it relevant to the individual who is asking)?
- Ways your organization protects PHI
  - 1. Role-based access to Electronic Health Records (EHR)
  - 2. Encryption
  - 3. HIPAA privacy and security policies (highlight certain policies i.e. mobile device, social media)
- How does staff protect PHI?
  - 1. Never share your password, key card/fobs
  - 2. Log off promptly from EHR
  - 3. Ensure all forms of PHI (written, electronic, verbal) are secure
  - 4. Use secure server when working remotely
  - 5. Timely reporting of any potential incident breach

#### Gifting

- Outlined in Code of Conduct and Gifting policy
- Review your gifting policy related to accepting gifts from residents, families and vendors
  - 1. Perishable or consumable gifts
  - 2. Will or trust
  - 3. Solicitation
- Review your gifting policy related to giving gifts to residents
- Cannot serve as a resident's executor, trustee, administrator, or guardian or provide financial services or act under a power of attorney for a resident

### **Disclosing PHI to Family and Friends**

- Review HIPAA policy on Disclosure of PHI to Family and Friends
- Require written or oral consent from resident (Where is Request to Restrict the Use and Disclosure of PHI form located?)
- Give resident opportunity to object to the request to disclose
- To whom should all requests be directed?
