

E-015- Provision of Subsistence Needs Overlaps with a number of K-Tags Needs for staff and residents whether they evacuate or shelter-in-place include but not limited to the following: • Food, water, medical and pharmaceutical supplies • Alternate sources of energy to maintain the following: • Temperatures to protect patient health & safety • Temperatures for sanitary storage of provisions • Emergency lighting • Fire detection, extinguishing and alarm systems • Sewage and waste disposal Should consider subsistence needs of volunteers, visitors and others sheltering at the facility during an event Facilities certified after 10/1/90- Temps 71 – 81 degrees F ** Medicare/Medicaid Certification date in front of plan **
